

NURSING POST-MASTER'S CERTIFICATE

Advanced Practice: Pediatric Nurse Practitioner, Adult- Gerontology Nurse Practitioner, Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner and Family Nurse Practitioner

These certificate programs are designed to prepare the nurse practitioner with a master's degree in nursing to attain an additional nurse practitioner certification. They are 18-39 credit programs (credit determination is made through a gap analysis). Students gain in-depth knowledge of human development and develop clinical skills necessary for complete advanced health assessment and management of primary, acute, psychiatric, pediatric and family health conditions.

Clinical placements are individualized and congruent with certification requirements. Placement is made with certified, experienced advanced nurse practitioners. Upon completion of the programs, graduates are eligible to apply for certification as advanced nurse practitioners with the appropriate certifying body.
