

PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR (B.S.)

In addition to meeting the standards and requirements of the University Core and of the College of Arts and Sciences B.S. Core, B.S. degree candidates must complete a minimum of 44 credits in psychology of which 27 are required. MATH 1401 Calculus I is also required. Students must earn at least a C- in PSYC 1101 Introduction to Psychology and PSYC 1201 Orientation to the Psychology Major. B.S. Psychology majors must earn at least a C- in each of the core sequence courses PSYC 1201 Orientation to the Psychology Major, PSYC 2311 Elementary Psychological Statistics or MATH 2111 Statistics for Science Majors, PSYC 3311 Research Methods, and PSYC 5111 Seminar in Psychology, The PSYC classes may each be taken a maximum of two times.
